



## **EVENT GUIDE**

**Please read ALL these instructions carefully**

Welcome to the inaugural Rum City Burnouts, outlined below is everything you need to know about the event, including the event schedule and instructions upon arrival and throughout the weekend.

This Event Guide needs to be read in conjunction with Entry form attached.

**Please note that Bundaberg Motorplex is a Licenced venue, no alcohol or glass containers to be brought into the event. Security will be performing checks on all vehicles and trailers entering the venue and any or glass containers will be confiscated. Anti-social behaviour of any kind will not be tolerated. Refusal to accept these conditions will be instant eviction from the event – No Exceptions.**

All entrants will need to provide One (1) clear external photo of their vehicle with the completed entry form (for promotion and entry acceptance purposes). Full payment of your entry fee is required at the time of lodging your form, if your vehicle does not meet the minimum standards (as decided by Bundaberg Motorplex) you will be offered a full refund of your entry fee. To ensure successful entrants get plenty of track time we will be limiting numbers. Bundaberg Motorplex reserves the right to refuse entry to any vehicle.

### **Event Arrival:**

Camping for competitors and crew is free for Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> & Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2018 within your allocated pit area.

Competitor packs and armbands will be available at the front gate from 7am Saturday morning, anyone still within the venue will be directed to the front gate at this time. Once inside the venue Entrants will be directed to their allocated pit area, Scrutineering starts at 7am, closes at 12pm and will be held under the carport near the Track Office in the pits area.

Tow / Support vehicles can be driven into the venue, please unload as quick as possible and make sure all Competitors, Tow & Support Vehicles are parked within your allocated pit area at all times.

If you're arriving on Friday, please proceed through to the Track Office in the pit area to be directed to your allocated pit area.

### **Pit Area Allocation:**

Pit areas are split into classes with Pro Blown on the first 2 rows closest to the track, Open V8 row 3, with 4 & 6 Cyl on row 4. Competitors requesting to pit with a group on their entry form will be allocated an area along the outer pit fence areas. Your Pit allocation will be provided in your Competitor Pack at the Main Gate on Saturday Morning or if arriving Friday, please proceed to the Track Office.

Entrants may bring in their own Shade or Marquee, but these MUST be adequately secured to avoid any damage or harm to other entrants or spectators. Bundaberg Motorplex accepts no responsibility for Entrant provided Marquees.

Pit areas are to be left clean, tidy and free of any rubber, wire, rubbish or used tyres & rims, please use the bins provided and take your tyres home.

Failure to adhere to these rules will see exclusion from future events at Bundaberg Motorplex.

### **Rules to adhere to for the Event:**

**This event will be conducted by Bundaberg Motorplex Pty Ltd, by entering this event you agree to comply with these regulations. Bundaberg Motorplex reserves the right to modify these rules at any time.**

1. **DRIVING IN THE PIT AREA MUST BE WALKING PACE AS THERE WILL BE SPECTATORS AROUND... FAILURE TO ADHERE TO THIS WILL SEE YOUR VEHICLE STICKER REMOVED...**
2. A vehicle inspection will be completed on any vehicle competing in any of the driving events, including cruise the track. All loose items must be removed from the vehicle prior to inspection.
3. No unreasonable body damage will be permitted, some belt rash will be permitted. No holes in the firewall, no cracked windscreens. Cars to be neat and presentable.
4. For the Burnouts a 360-degree tail shaft loop must be fitted, the exception being vehicles fitted with a 2-piece tail shaft.
5. Drivers & Passengers - Long sleeve shirt, long pants, shoes and an approved helmet must be worn during Burnouts.
6. Please remove all press on hubcaps, wheel trims & Wheels Weights prior to vehicle inspection.
7. Numbers will be restricted to a maximum of 40 entrants for Pro Blown, 25 for Open V8, 20 for 4 & 6 Cyl and 15 for Ladies/Exhibition.
8. Vehicles do not need to be registered to participate BUT must be capable of passing a vehicle inspection.
9. Motorcycles are not eligible to enter the event or allowed in pit area.
10. No fuel, oil or Brake LEAKS. All fittings must be securely fastened.
11. Tyres must be in good condition, no steel belts hanging out or canvas showing.
12. Seat belts must be in good working order
13. Bonnets are NOT compulsory. However, all ancillary drive belts must be covered.
14. Each vehicle with mechanically operated throttles must be fitted with secondary accelerator return spring.
15. Where wheel arches are cut to fit tyres, each subsequent opening so created shall be closed without sharp edges to ensure separation between burnt rubber and fuel tank.
16. Exhaust is not compulsory.
17. Entrant Window Stickers are **NOT** to be removed until after the EVENT.
18. No wheel weights for the burnout competition.
19. No structural rust. Brake and fuel lines must be at a safe distance from the exhaust.
20. All vehicles must be fitted with a 1-litre radiator overflow or water catch bottle and ensure there are no leaks from the rocker covers.
21. All batteries must be clamped; however, they can be located in the boot.
22. It is recommended that all Entrants have a Fire Extinguisher securely fitted inside their vehicle.
23. **PLEASE NOTE:** No **Glass**, if found it will be taken and **NOT** returned.

**Please note that Entrants and Crew can camp Friday & Saturday Night.**

\*\* The trophy Presentation will be after the completion of the Burnout Finals. To receive your awards, you have to be present or have someone there to represent you, as the prizes are too big to be posted.

## **GENERAL RULES**

All drivers are required to have **ZERO** blood alcohol level; Random breath testing WILL be conducted at any time during the event. Any Driver found to have a blood alcohol reading will be forced to park their car immediately.

Anti-social behaviour or failure to follow any rules or directions of event staff may see you disqualified from the event or in more serious cases evicted from the venue and banned from future competition.

The decisions of Bundaberg Motorplex and event staff are final and there will be no grounds for protest.

## **SPEEDWAY TRACK CRUISE**

The Cruise is to give the spectators a close-up view and sounds of the competitors vehicles, take your mates for a spin (with Passenger Arm Band) and warm up the cars.

1. If a Track Official displays a Flag in your direction you are to stop immediately and **NOT** proceed until directed by an official, if a yellow flag is shown, slow down.
2. No overtaking on the Speedway Track Cruise unless necessary. Overtake only when it's safe to do so.
3. No Racing, No Wheel Spinning allowed – Maximum Speed 30kmh
4. No driver changes can be made
5. All occupants must wear a seat belt, **NO SEAT BELT, NO CRUISING.** No part of the body to be outside the vehicle, no persons allowed in the back of Utes.
6. No stopping to do Burnouts during the cruise session, if you do STOP to do a burnout, don't bother as you will be asked to **PARK** your vehicle immediately.
7. Competitors must be ready to proceed onto the track when they are instructed to do so by an official.
8. Cruise sessions will be split into groups if necessary
9. If the vehicle stops for any reason, everyone must remain in the vehicle until the safety vehicle/officer arrives.
10. Speedway Cruise cars can have as many passengers as they want as long as each passenger has their own Seat belt.
11. Do not have any one in your car without a PASSENGER ARM BAND. This is the COMPETITOR'S responsibility.
12. **FAILURE TO ADHERE TO THESE RULES WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AT ALL. Promoters will not hesitate to remove entrant stickers and armbands if you cannot adhere to this requirement.**

## **BURNOUT RULES**

**All Burnout Entrants will line-up in the pit area when the class is called over the pit PA & FM Radio channel (Channel Number will be on display at scrutineering) and enter the Burnout Pad through the Track Entry Gate once instructed by event staff.**

### **Burnout Rules & Regulations**

1. No entrant will be allowed to swap burnout groups unless agreed to by the Promoter.
2. All cars to assemble (with driver) when called for by the Announcer.
3. Cars to be turned out in a presentable fashion.
4. NO static burnouts are allowed.
5. Burnout Points are detailed below.
6. All Entrants will be given 90 seconds to qualify with a maximum burnout of 2 minutes, no points will be given after the 90 second cut-off. Timeframe may be subject to change depending upon number of entrants.
7. Following the completion of eliminations for each class, a list of the top 10 will be displayed at the back of the control tower and announced over the PA System.
8. All Drivers are to **STOP** if they see an official's red flag, red light or the Siren is sounded. If you fail to Stop you will be disqualified.
9. All tyres are to be taken away by the Competitor, **DO** not leave blown tyres at your site.
10. Passengers are allowed in the Competitor's vehicle as long as each person has a seat belt and has the appropriate Passenger Armband after signing the Disclaimer. Armband must be visible before entering the Burnout Pad.
11. Driver and ALL passengers must wear an Australian Standard approved helmet, long sleeve shirt and pants during Burnouts. Shoes must be worn at all times. No thongs or sandals allowed to be worn in the pit area.

12. For the Burnouts a 360-degree tail shaft loop must be fitted, the exception being vehicles fitted with a 2-piece tail shaft.
13. We recommend a fire suit to be worn, but that is at the Entrants and Passengers Discretion.
14. Once Tyres are Blown get off the Burnout Pad via the Pit Exit Gate.
15. All vehicles driving in the pits and track arena on way to pad must travel at **NO MORE THAN WALKING PACE** **Anyone found to be speeding through the pit area will be immediately disqualified from the event.**
16. During Burnouts, Drivers and passengers must remain properly restrained in their seat, seat belt must be over the shoulder (not under arm). **Failure to abide by this Safety Rule will mean Instant Disqualification.**

## **CLASSES**

### **PRO BLOWN**

Pro Blown is open to all Supercharged, Turbo & Nitrous Vehicles with a proven capability of taking on the best in the business, proof of experience may be required such as videos or past results, some Naturally Aspirated may be accepted at the discretion of Bundaberg Motorplex.

Entry is via BUY-IN ONLY at \$500 per entry with multiple buy-ins allowed for the same vehicle or driver.

Prize structure will be **WINNER TAKES ALL**, e.g. 10 entries \$5,000, 20 entries \$10,000, 30 entries \$15,000 and a maximum of 40 entries **\$20,000!** If there are less than 40 entries, the prize pool will be the total sum of all Pro Blown Buy-Ins with a minimum of \$5000

### **OPEN V8**

Open V8 is open to all Naturally Aspirated V8 cars, No Supercharged, Turbo or Nitrous Vehicles Allowed.

There are 2 ways to enter:

- a) By Qualifying at one of our FRYDAY NIGHT SKIDZ Events on the 7<sup>th</sup> September or 12<sup>th</sup> October 2018 and receiving an invite to enter RUM CITY BURNOUTS by Bundaberg Motorplex. Two secret judges are in attendance and will judge your first 2 skids and presentation of vehicle.
- b) If you are unable to attend one of our FRYDAY NIGHT SKIDZ Events and think you have what it takes, send us an email or Facebook Message with your details, Photo or Video of your car and a brief run down on your past results to [admin@bundabergmotorplex.com.au](mailto:admin@bundabergmotorplex.com.au) or the Bundaberg Motorplex Facebook Page. Bundaberg Motorplex will review the details and reply as soon as possible.

Entry is \$150 per driver, the prize pool will consist of all the Open V8 entry fees paid to the top 3 place getters, 25 entries maximum will see a prize pool of \$3750, 1<sup>st</sup> \$2000, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$1000, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$750. If there are less than 25 entries, Bundaberg Motorplex will divide the prize pool accordingly e.g. 15 cars \$1000, \$750, \$500.

### **4 & 6 CYL**

Open V8 is open to all 4 & 6 Cylinder Supercharged, Turbo and Naturally Aspirated Cars, No Nitrous Vehicles allowed

There are 2 ways to enter:

- c) By Qualifying at one of our FRYDAY NIGHT SKIDZ Events on the 7<sup>th</sup> September or 12<sup>th</sup> October 2018 and receiving an invite to enter RUM CITY BURNOUTS by Bundaberg Motorplex. Two secret judges are in attendance and will judge your first 2 skids and presentation of vehicle.
- d) If you are unable to attend one of our FRYDAY NIGHT SKIDZ Events and think you have what it takes, send us an email or Facebook Message with your details, Photo or Video of your car and a brief run down on your past results to [admin@bundabergmotorplex.com.au](mailto:admin@bundabergmotorplex.com.au) or the Bundaberg Motorplex Facebook Page. Bundaberg Motorplex will review the details and reply as soon as possible.

Entry is \$100 per driver, the prize pool will consist of all the 4 & 6 Cyl entry fees paid to the top 3 place getters, 20 entries maximum will see a prize pool of \$2000, 1<sup>st</sup> \$1000, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$600, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$400. If there are less than 20 entries, Bundaberg Motorplex will divide the prize pool accordingly e.g. 10 cars \$500, \$300, \$200.

## **LADIES**

Ladies is open to all Women entering with Naturally Aspirated V8 Cars, 4 & 6 Cylinder Supercharged, Turbo and Naturally Aspirated Cars, No Nitrous Vehicles allowed.

There are 2 ways to enter:

- e) By Qualifying at one of our FRYDAY NIGHT SKIDZ Events on the 7<sup>th</sup> September or 12<sup>th</sup> October 2018 and receiving an invite to enter RUM CITY BURNOUTS by Bundaberg Motorplex. Two secret judges are in attendance and will judge your first 2 skids and presentation of vehicle.
- f) If you are unable to attend one of our FRYDAY NIGHT SKIDZ Events and think you have what it takes, send us an email or Facebook Message with your details, Photo or Video of your car and a brief run down on your past results to [admin@bundabergmotorplex.com.au](mailto:admin@bundabergmotorplex.com.au) or the Bundaberg Motorplex Facebook Page. Bundaberg Motorplex will review the details and reply as soon as possible.

Entry is \$100 per driver, the prize pool will consist of all the Ladies Class entry fees paid to the top 3 place getters, 10 entries maximum will see a prize pool of \$1000, 1<sup>st</sup> \$500, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$300, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$200. If there are less than 10 entries, Bundaberg Motorplex will divide the prize pool accordingly e.g. 10 cars \$250, \$150, \$100.

- We will have a minimum of 3 Judges scoring the event.
- A Final judge's scorecard will be made available after the completion of the event.
- Please note that all judges' scores are final, and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the Judges Scores.
- If you have an issue with the judging, please contact the Promoters to discuss further.
- Promoters will not be involved in the scoring of the event to avoid any perceived bias.

### **PASSENGERS:**

Passengers must sign on with the Competitor on arrival. We will not be giving Arm bands out for the Competitor to take AWAY. They will be secured on the passenger's wrist on arrival, then the passenger has to **sign a disclaimer**, if they want to be a passenger in the Burnouts or Cruise the Track

No passengers are allowed in the COMPETITOR vehicle **WITHOUT AN ARM BAND**  
Officials will check this regularly.

**REMEMBER this is the responsibility of the Entrant to make sure passengers have the correct armband, if you are found attempting to enter the arena or pad with a passenger that does not have the correct arm band, YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**

## **TRANSPORTER AND TRAILER PARKING**

In order to avoid unnecessary congestion all transporters and trailers must be entirely within your allocated pit area or contact event staff an alternative area to park the transporter in, otherwise all Tow, Support and Competitor vehicles **must** be parked within your allocated pit bay.

## **CAMPING RULES**

- Competitors & their crew are all welcome to camp at Bundaberg Motorplex for the duration of the event.
- Bundaberg Motorplex management reserves the right to refuse camping and/or move Competitors to other sites at our discretion if deemed necessary.
- It is the responsibility of the COMPETITOR to make sure the camping area is kept CLEAN at all times, anyone found not keeping the area clean or leaving their pit area in a mess will not be welcome back for future events.
- Any unsocial, loud or violent behaviour by the COMPETITOR or the Crew will **NOT BE TOLERATED AT ALL** and all parties involved **WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE VENUE IMMEDIATELY.**
- **NO Motor Bikes AT ALL**
- You may bring in your own Marquee, tent or Shade, make sure it is secured and set up properly
- **ATTENTION:** Please be aware, this is a camping area and we ask that you respect other campers by keeping the noise to a minimum.
- Due to Council restrictions, **no competition car to be started OR driven after 10:30pm, NO REVING OF ENGINES AFTER 9PM**
- **PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU CLEAN THE AREA AND LEAVE IT AS YOU FOUND IT.**

**BUNDABERG MOTORPLEX RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY, DISQUALIFY OR REMOVE ANY PERSON FOR ANY REASON WITHOUT COURSE OF APPEAL.**
